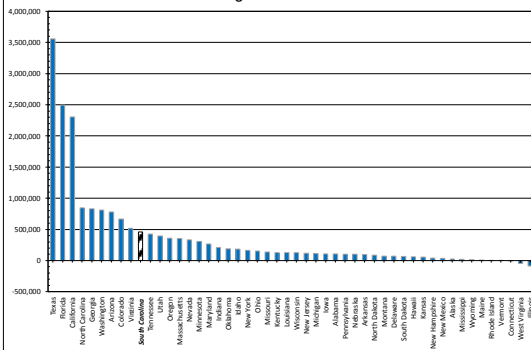

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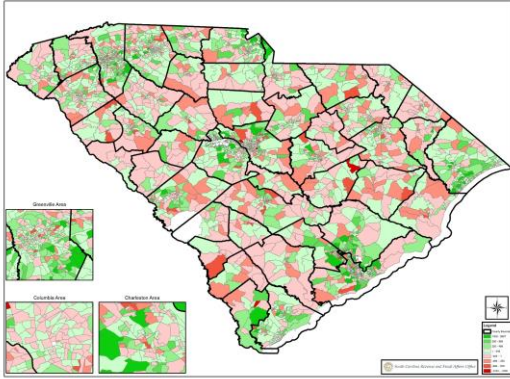
UNITED STATES CENSUS POPULATION

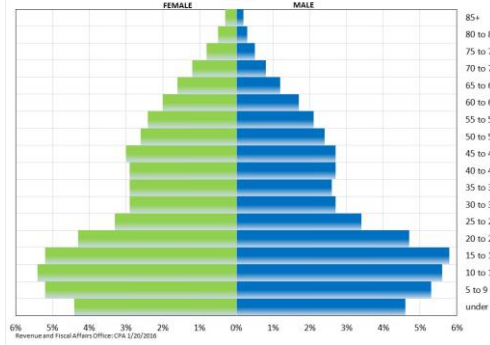
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SOUTH CAROLINA POPULATION CHANGE 2010-2017



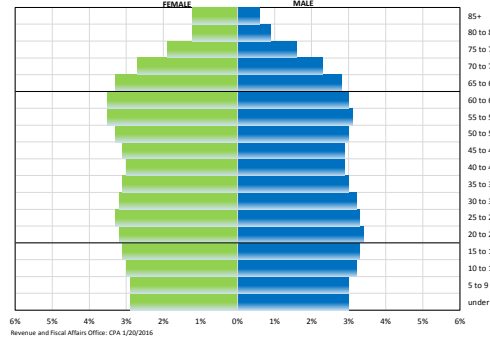

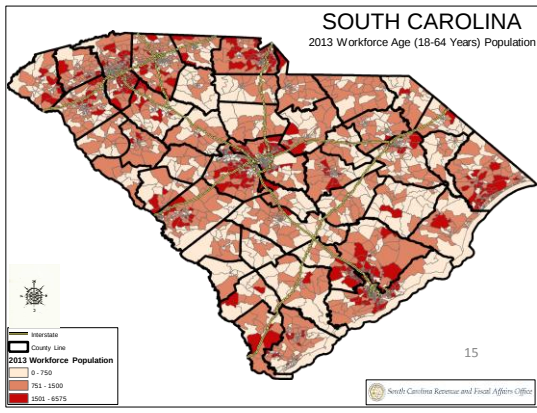


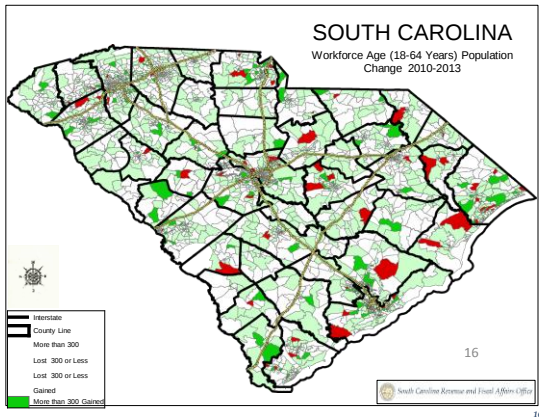
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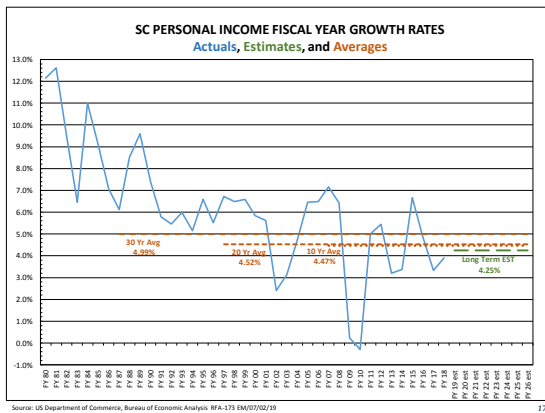


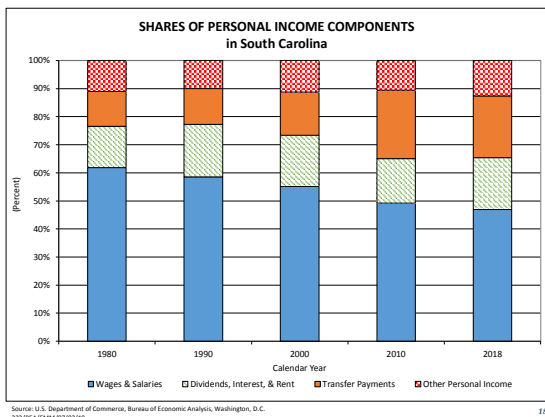


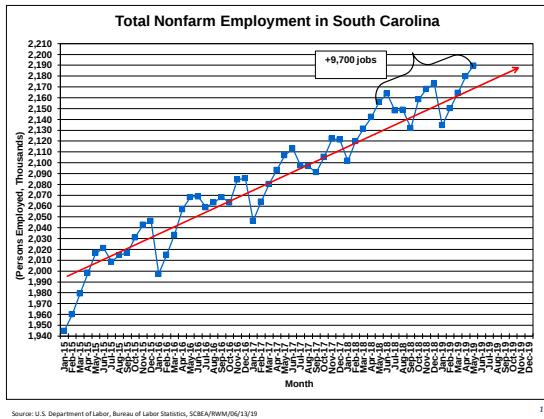


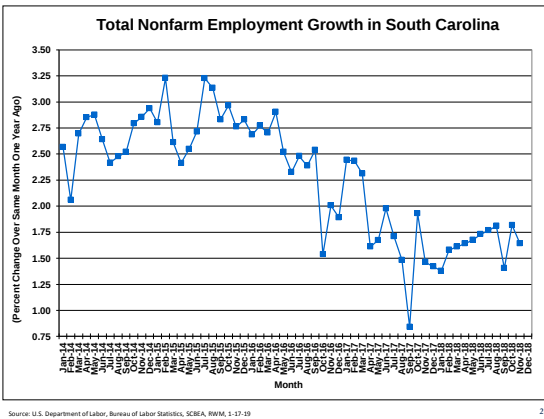


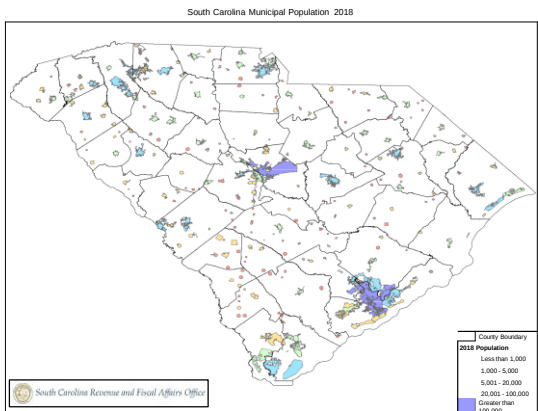




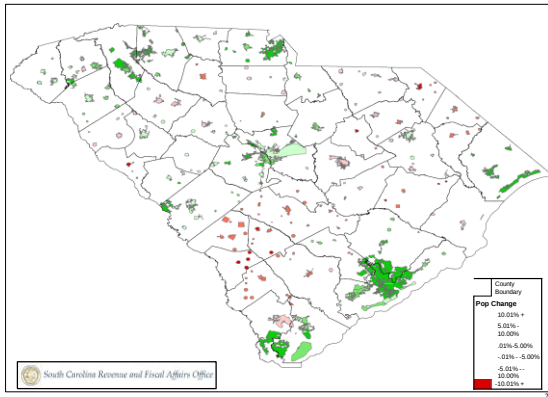




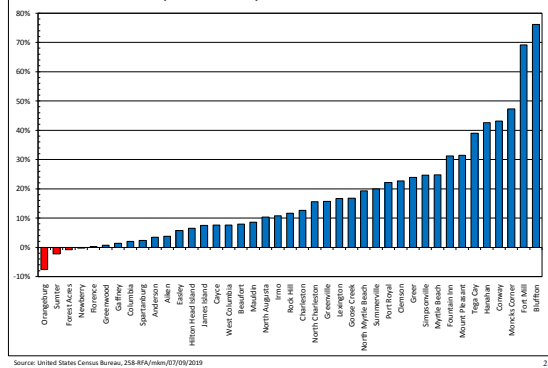




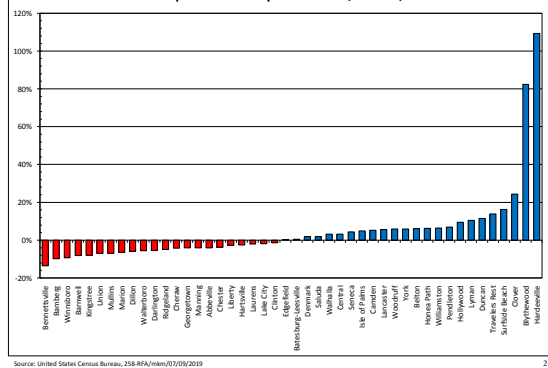
South Carolina Municipal Population Change 2010 - 2018

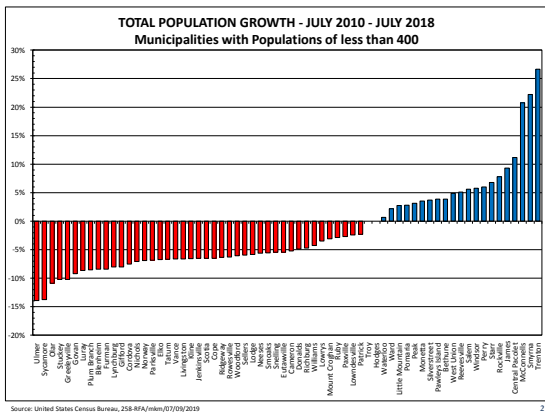
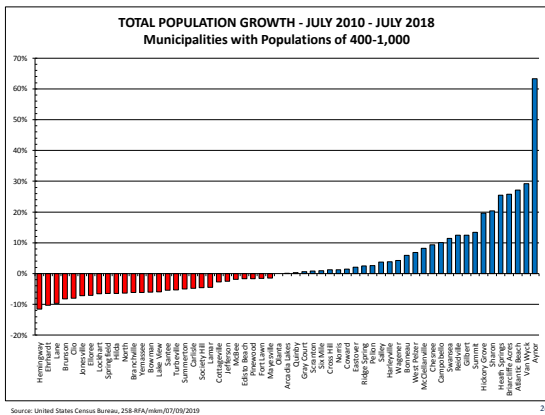
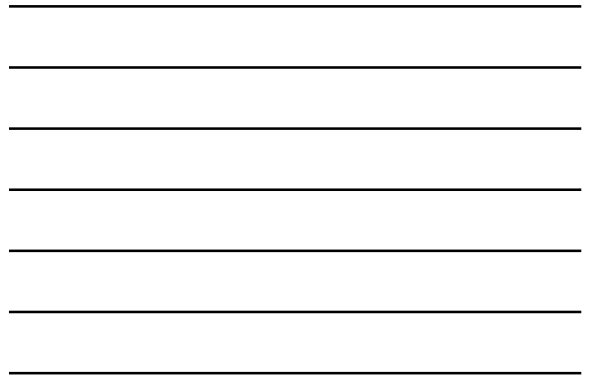
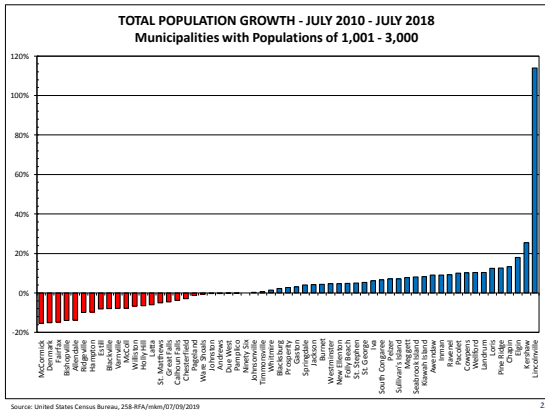


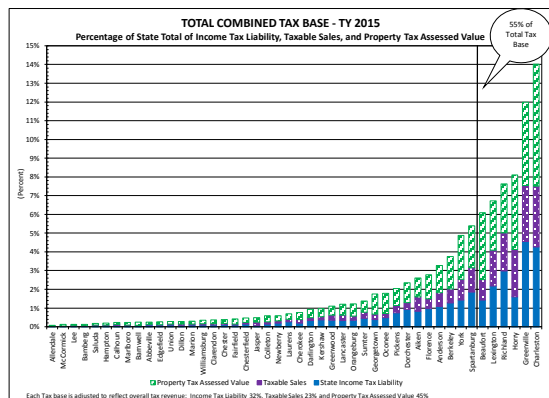
TOTAL POPULATION GROWTH - JULY 2010 - JULY 2018
Municipalities with Populations of More Than 10,000



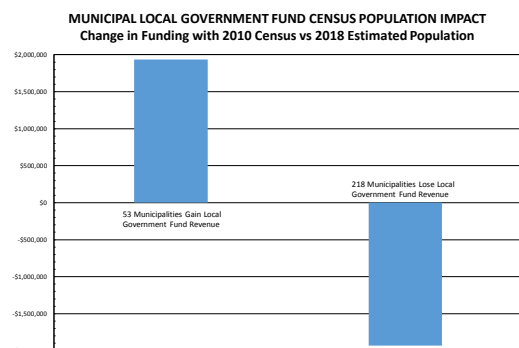
TOTAL POPULATION GROWTH - JULY 2010 - JULY 2018
