Professionals licensed to practice engineering and land surveying in South Carolina are required to demonstrate continuing development of professional competency as a condition for registration renewal. These requirements are outlined in Article 6, Chapter 49, Code of Regulations of South Carolina. Every licensee, except those exempted in R49-606, is required to obtain 30 PDH units each biennial renewal period. If a licensee exceeds the requirements in any renewal period, a maximum of 15 PDH units may be carried forward into the subsequent renewal period.
