The Clemson Extension Carolina Clear Program provides educational outreach through on-site visits, webinars, workshops, hybrid courses, and both print and online resources to raise awareness of actions and behaviors to help protect and manage water quantity and quality.

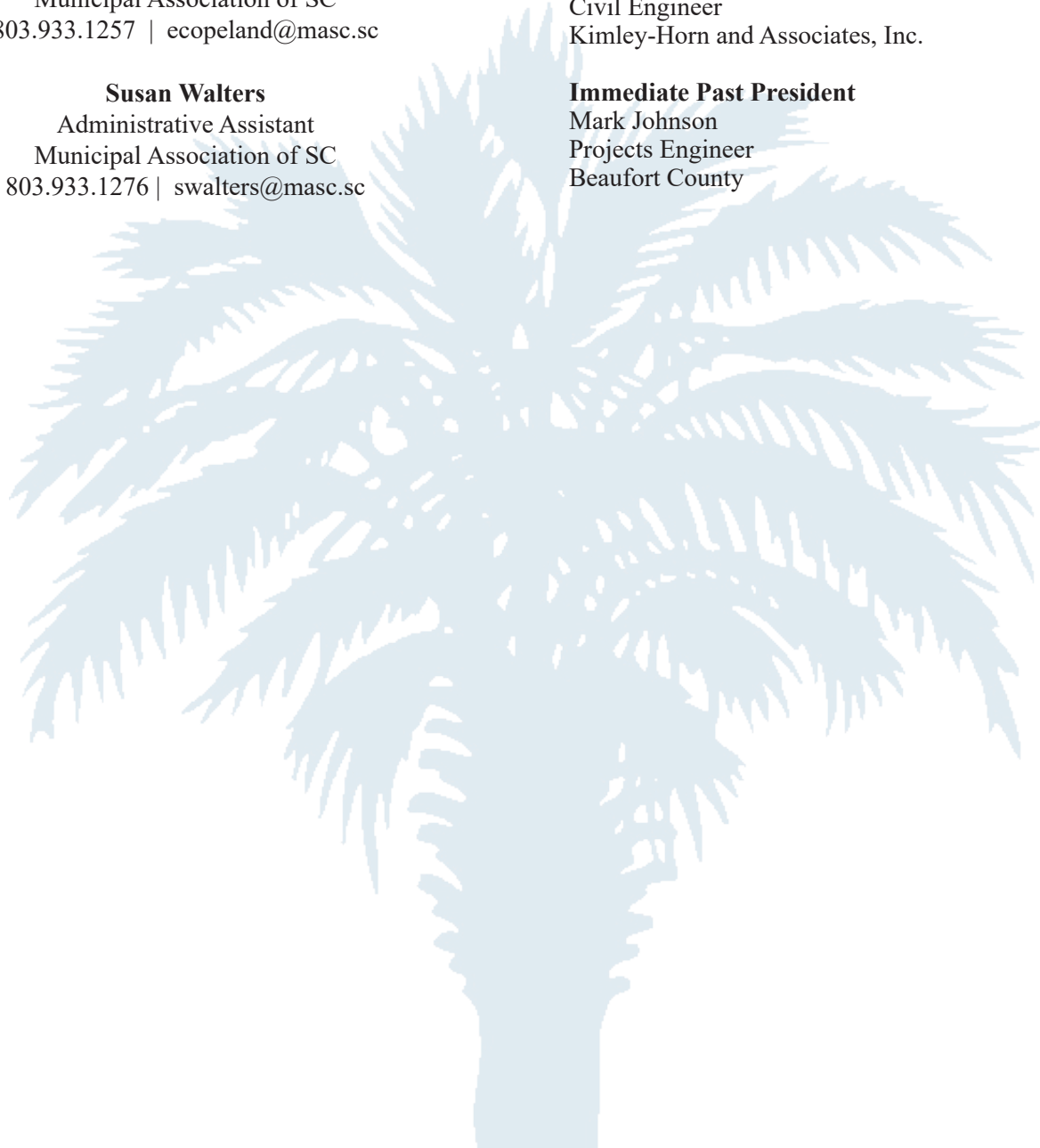
